

## Wind Surf Fact Sheet

<b>The Ship:</b>	Wind Surf
<b>Passenger Capacity:</b>	312 passengers (based on double occupancy)
<b>Public Areas:</b>	Wind Surf Lounge, Casino, The Yacht Club, Compass Rose Bar, Pool Bar, Terrace Bar, Water Sports Platform (aft), 2 Salt-Water Pools, 2 Hot Tubs, WindSpa, Fitness Center, Nautilus Center Meeting Room, Degrees, The Restaurant, Le Marché, Candles, Reception, Signature Shop, Photo Gallery and Bridge Visitation Policy.
<b>Staterooms:</b>	123 deluxe, ocean-view staterooms, with queen beds (converts to two twins), and a sitting area. Some offer a third berth.
<b>Suites:</b>	31 deluxe ocean-view suites which are 376 square feet or 35 square meters. Additional amenities include an extra bath, TV and sitting area. Spa suites include all the amenities of a suite along with luxurious microfiber linens, spa robes, an orchid flower arrangement, specialty pillow menu, daily fresh fruit platter, O SPA London products, WindSpa spa experiences and events as well as unlimited Pilates and Yoga classes. Bridge Suites, which are 495 square feet, include a living room, bedroom and bathroom with jetted tub and separate shower.
<b>Stateroom Amenities:</b>	Closed circuit LCD flatscreen television, DVD/CD players, personal safe, refrigerator, mini-bar, international direct-dial phones, wireless Internet, Bose SoundDock speakers, cell phone service, private bathrooms with shower, toiletries by L'Occitane, hair dryer, vanity, magnifying mirrors, Euro-Top mattresses, luxury bedding, Egyptian cotton towels, plush robes, slippers, fresh fruit and flowers. Each stateroom is equipped with one standard U.S. 110 and European 220 volt (converter recommended), 60 cycle AC electric outlets.
<b>Crew:</b>	191 international staff. The Captain and nautical staff are European. Hotel senior staff are American and European. Stewards and service personnel are Filipino and Indonesian.
<b>Services:</b>	Reception, Signature Shop, Sports Platform, 24-Hour In-Room Dining, WindSpa, Infirmary with full-time Physician and Nurse, Laundry Service, Computers, Internet and E-mail, Cell Phone Service, DVDs, CDs, iPod Nanos, Laptops, Games and Books.
<b>Dining:</b>	Windstar offers an open seating program allowing guests to dine when and with whom they like. Four restaurants: The Restaurant, Degrees, Le Marché and Candles. The Restaurant accommodates 250 guests. Degrees seats 124 guests for a Mediterranean culinary journey of simple cooking and seasonal preparations, showcasing authentic ingredients and classic techniques. Two new evening dining experiences await guests on <i>Wind Surf</i> . Romance is under sail as guests enjoy water

views, exquisite sunsets and stars while dining alfresco on five-star cuisine in Le Marché or Candles. Le Marché is a seafood bar on *Wind Surf's* Star Deck offering a delectable array of fish and shellfish and accommodates 30 guests. Candles is a poolside grill on *Wind Surf's* Main Deck offering fine steaks and skewers and accommodates 30 guests.

Light and vegetarian cuisine available on request. The Veranda and Terrace serves breakfast and lunch, while continental breakfast and afternoon tea are served in the Compass Rose.

<b>Meeting Space:</b>	The Nautilus Center accommodates groups for private meetings and events. Available equipment includes audio-visual, display boards, photocopying, overhead slide and video projection. The Terrace Bar may also be reserved for special events.
<b>Water Sports:</b>	Complimentary water-skiing, windsurfing, kayaking, sailing, ski-tubing and snorkel gear. Scuba diving is available for a fee.

<b>Year built:</b>	1990 as the Club Med I. Extensively renovated in 1998, 2000, 2003 and 2006. Degrees of Difference enhancements completed in 2006 and 2010.
