

HOW ABOUT A BIG PIECE OF ICE?



The **Falkland Islands** are truly a paradise for bird lovers – you will find more than 60 species of birds here, such as the majestic black-browed albatross. The islands are comparable with the Norwegian Lofoten Islands – a rocky, but nevertheless green landscape with blooming gorse dominates the picture.



The island **South Georgia**, partly covered by glaciers, is an attraction just for the tremendously diverse fauna – more than 200,000 king penguins as well as elephant seals, fur seals and macaroni penguins live here. Bird enthusiasts are also thrilled to see the great brooding colonies of albatrosses and southern giant petrels.



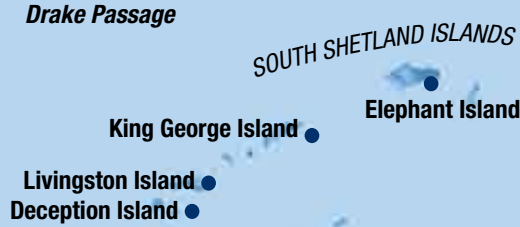
Paradise Bay received its name from whalers long years ago because it seemed to them to be a paradise frozen in ice. It is not at all unusual to see humpback whales during a Zodiac landing.

Active volcanoes created the water-filled crater of the **Deception Island** in the ancient past. Hot springs still bubble away on the shores of the crater lake, inviting you to take an Antarctic bath.



The **South Orkney Islands** are among the loneliest in the world. 85% of their area is covered by glacial ice. This is also the site of the Argentinean research station Orcada – it has been in continuous operation since 1905, making it the oldest station in Antarctica.

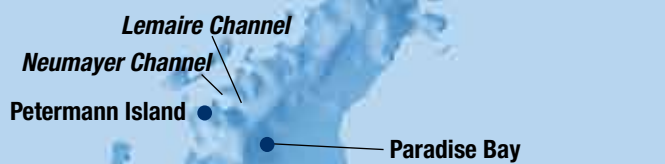

You can observe large colonies of Adelie penguins and gentoo penguins on **Petermann Island**. An interesting side note: the island was discovered by a German expedition in 1873.



The **Lemaire Channel** and the **Neumayer Channel** are two of the most beautiful ship passageways in the world – bizarre icebergs in all shades of blue will amaze you in this strait.



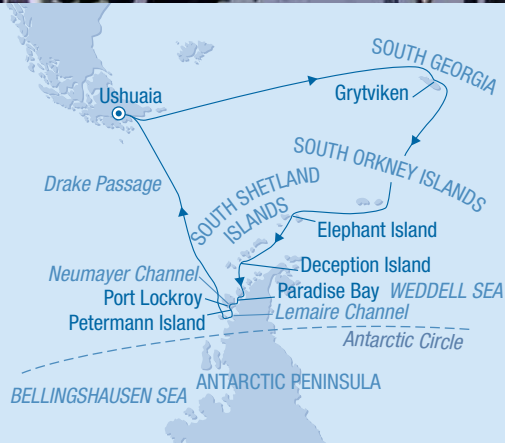
BELLINGSHAUSEN SEA



The Antarctic icebergs rise like giant towers from the water – their colours vary in innumerable shades of blue and put on a spectacle which is unique in the world.



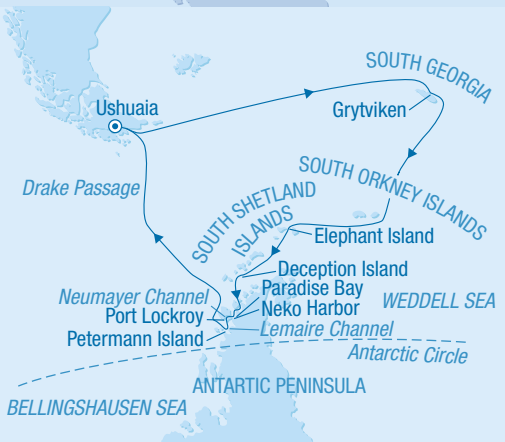

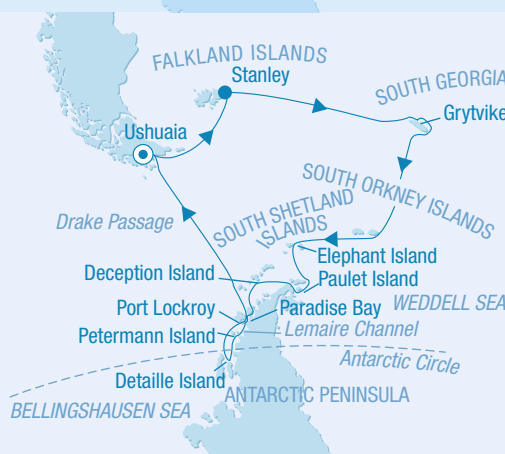
