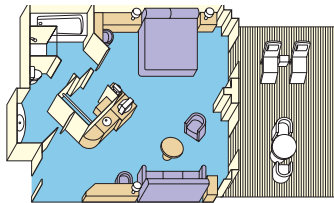

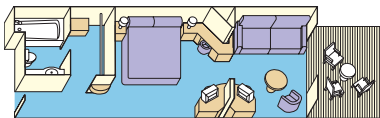

Surrounding you with luxurious accommodations, a spacious suite with balcony includes all the amenities of a mini-suite, plus incredible premiums. These include

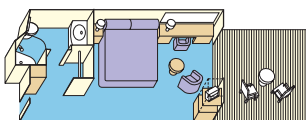

A mini-suite with balcony is substantially larger than a balcony stateroom.

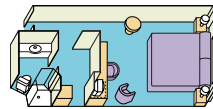

Oceanview double with balcony

This impressive stateroom offers the elegance of a balcony with fine patio furniture. Other

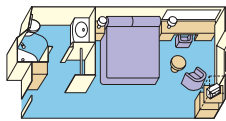

Deluxe oceanview

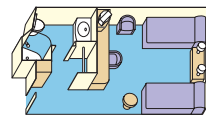
A slightly larger version of an oceanview double stateroom with the same fine amenities, including a picture window.

Our oceanview stateroom includes all the amenities of an interior double, plus it features a picture window, providing added ambience and memorable views. Approximately 146-165 square feet. (Categories D, E, F, GG & G; Categories GG & G have obstructed views; Category F has portholes)



Interior double

Our interior stateroom is a great value. It features two twin beds that make up into a queen-size bed. Other amenities include a refrigerator, hair dryer, TV, closet and bathroom with shower. Approximately 158 square feet. (Categories II, I, J, K & L)
